Letter from Louisiana

In February I went to Mardi Gras in New Orleans. The floats were amazing and the atmosphere was great!! The parade I was at lasted about 3 hours, with themed floats going past throwing beads, stuffed toys, candy, flowers, headbands and ornaments into the crowd.
