Boys Relay Team 3rd

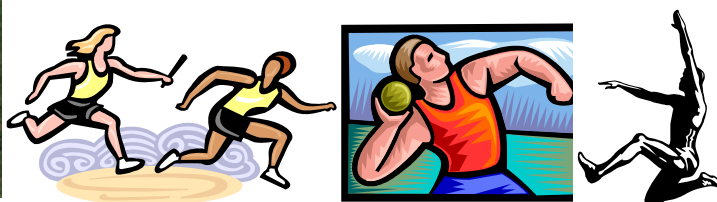
Gareth Gardyne 3rd Shot Put heat
