We are watching the Influenza A situation and monitoring what is happening among staff and students carefully. So far we know of no Influenza A cases in the school community.

We would like to thank parents who are watching their children and keeping those who are ill at home. Please continue to do this and please ring the absences into school in the morning.

Teachers are monitoring the situation at school and are referring any students of concern to the school Health Centre where Jeanie Nasey checks them thoroughly.

The school has preparations for a closure in hand. Should there be a case in the College the school will evaluate the circumstances and consult with the health authorities before making a decision to close.

A decision to close the school is quite a serious matter. It will affect students and families considerably. Students will in effect be asked to stay at home. There is little point in a school closure if students at risk of getting the flu are out and about seeing friends or going to the movies or the malls.

In the event of a school closure students will come home with a newsletter. Information will also be posted on the school website.

Prevention is still the Key

- **Cover your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze.**
- **Don't cough or sneeze in to your hands without washing them immediately.**
- **Wash your hands regularly - at least 20 seconds with soap and water.**
- **Don't come to school if you have a cold or the flu.**
- **Consider staying home for one week after international travel.**
