The New Zealand Qualifications Authority and the Ministry of Education have been redeveloping the curriculum for NCEA courses. The revised Standards were introduced into Year 11 this year and will be introduced into Year 12 next year. To prepare for these changes the Minister of Education has authorised schools to take two Teacher Only Days to ensure that school courses are updated to include the revised Standards.

We have put these days off until the senior students were released to sit their NCEA examinations.
