The days were filled with fitness training, rock climbing, kayaking, sailing and tramping. This included a two day, two night solo expedition, sleeping in the bush with only the possums for company.

The team had to undertake a six day expedition where they depended on their own initiative, their newly acquired sailing skills and their own navigation and map reading skills. The trip involved two days sailing a cutter and four days of tramping that included a 15 hour day bashing through trackless bush. The adventure ended with everyone running a half marathon! Would she do it again? Oh, yes! In a flash!
