## Waitangi to Helensville - The Journey

Ten Year 10 students have completed a challenging journey by bike, foot and kayak from the Treaty grounds at Waitangi to the wharf at Helensville. The trip was designed to test their stamina and their mental toughness and develop leadership, self reliance and self confidence. It was sponsored by the Ministry of Social Development and run by Adventure Specialties who had two outdoor education experts on the trip accompanied by College Youth Worker Kelly Brown.

Each day one of the crew was appointed leader. The leader had to organise the day, get everyone up, read the map and plan the travel targets. There were seven days of cycling, three days of walking and one day of kayaking.



Everyone spoke about the climb over Mangonui Bluff which involved a 4am start and a twelve hour day of tramping. The best night was the last camp at Higham's Beach where there was a feast including treats brought in by kind adults. At 1.30pm on Friday ten tired students in seven kayaks wound their way up the twisting Awaroa river to a welcome by the College kapahaka group and families at the Helensville wharf.

Played in stunning conditions the match started with Glenfield College pinning Kaipara in their half for the first 20 minutes. Calm kicking from Kaipara first five Billy May allowed Kaipara to absorb a heap of pressure. Against the run of play Kaipara were able to score few phases later with impressive second five Duke Hemara crashing through the Glenfield defence to score a try. The Kaipara forward pack began to assert themselves and it was Glenfield's turn to absorb some pressure. Kaipara were able to land a penalty goal to take the score to 8-0. Only a penalty kick from Glenfield first five, Willy Unga, added to the score. The halftime score 8-3.

After scoring an early penalty goal Kaipara were again able to take advantage of some casual play from Glenfield College. Kaipara were able to turn the ball over and after some
