In 1925 Jean Ellett began her secondary schooling at Helensville District High School, now Kaipara College. Eighty five years later Jean, now Mrs Narbey, returned to officiate at the opening of the new science block.

Mrs Narbey, accompanied by three generations of her family, unveiled a plaque commemorating the opening at a school assembly run in her honour by the student leaders of 2010. She was accompanied to the new laboratories by the student leaders and her family where she cut a ribbon and declared the block open.
