## Charlotte Clouston Champion Mountain Biker

Charlotte has been mountain biking for a number of years but this year has seen her win the National Downhill title in both U19 and Open Women. This earned her automatic selection to the New Zealand team for the World Championships in Quebec in August/September.

As well as her national title Charlotte competed in the six event New Zealand Series which consists of two legs of racing, three races in the North island and three in the South. Charlotte recorded a first, a second and a third in the North Island and two firsts and a second in the South Island. She finished the event in first place but seeding points dropped her to second.

In the National Secondary School Championships Charlotte was third in the cross-country, fourth in uphill and fifth in the downhill. She was disappointed with this result but redeemed herself in the Auckland Championships where she won the Senior Girls' title.

Charlotte will now combine a focus on her study with training for the Worlds as this very determined young woman climbs to the top of her sport while she prepares for University.
